Your Negotiating Committee will be meeting U of T for bargaining meetings beginning Sept 19, 2022 and continue until we reach a fair collective agreement.

GOOD JOBS ARE DISAPPEARING FROM U OF T

Update: U of T has handed over <u>six additional buildings</u> to for-profit contractors who provide roughly 30% less in wages and minimal benefits. The continuing trend of contracting out is a serious threat to fair wages, benefits, and the future of good jobs at U of T.

- It devalues your work, pushing down the wage floor for service work
- It undermines fair working standards
- It weakens your bargaining power, making it harder to win fair wage increases



TAKE ACTION TO SECURE YOUR FUTURE!

If you and your co-workers build *maximum worker power* during this round of negotiations, it is possible to win a fair collective agreement that respects service work and stops contracting out.

Key union proposals against contracting out:

- Directly hire in-house U of T employees to ensure functional, clean, and safe campuses and buildings
- Improve job security language and increase good jobs at U of T to keep up with growing needs
- Post and fill vacant positions, and share staffing information with the union



WHAT DOES INFLATION MEAN FOR YOU?

You got only a 1% annual wage increase from July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021 because of the Conservative Government's Bill 124.

Bill 124 also only allows a maximum of 1% annual increases until June 30, 2023. However, inflation is over 7%, which means your wages are not keeping up with rising costs.

You deserve better. That's why it's important for us to be more united and stronger than ever. Fighting contracting out and winning good jobs at U of T will increase your bargaining power and give us the best shot at winning fair wage increases after 2023.
